- Have you reviewed the DRAFT District 8 4-H Rifle Rules & Texas 4-H Indoor Rifle Match Rules?
  - What questions do you have?
  - Roy Green, Erath County volunteer, will serve as the range officer.
  - Anything not addressed in the District 8-specific rules or the Texas 4-H Indoor Rifle Match Rules will be referenced back to the NRA rules.
  - These rules are used because this is a state-qualifying event for Senior 4-H members.
  - Relays will be done similar to last year. Seniors will go first, followed by Intermediates, then Juniors. A more detailed schedule will be sent after entries are received and processed.
  - There will be two ranges again this year. Light Rifle will start at approximately 10 am.
