

Current Domain password complexity Rules:

- At least 8 characters
- Does not contain any part of your account or full name
- Contains at least three of the following character groups:
 1. English uppercase characters (A through Z)
 2. English lowercase characters (a through z)
 3. Numerals (0 through 9)
 4. Non-alphabetic characters (such as !, \$, #, %)

How do I create a complex password?

The best way is to take a phrase that is easy for you to remember and then use uppercase letters in random places and substitute numbers and symbols for letters.

Example: “My Dog Has Fleas” = MyD0gH@sF13@s!

Another option is to take a familiar phrase and reduce it down to the first letters of each word (again using random uppercase letters and substituting numbers and symbols for letters).

0sCysBtD3L? (Can you figure that one out? Hint: you sing it at every sports event.)

NOTE: Neither of these examples is a secure password as they are both public information at this time. Please do not use either of these as a password for your account.
